WILMONT — The 47th annual session of the Raleigh District Church School and Educational Varick Christian Endeavor Convention, was held at the Union Chapel AME Zion church, at Wilton, N. C. Rev. J. W. Pennington, pastor July 9-11 with Dr. T. P. Madkins, D.D., D.Th., president of the district presiding. This meeting and all similar meetings held in Central North Carolina are under the jurisdiction of Bishop R. L. Jones, D.D., I.L.D., bishop of Central North Carolina, East Tennessee, Virginia, Pee Dee and Indiana.

The theme of the convention was "Crisis for Christ" and the theme song was the old Christian battle song "Stand Up, Stand Up For Jesus."

The entire meeting could well be called a symposium of consecration, highlighted as it was by the uplifting annual sermon of Dr. J. C. Curtis, the health hour discussion led by Dr. O. Max King, the inspiring educational address of Dr. S. L. Brown and the heart stirring and soul reaching closing sermon of the Reverend Mrs. Mable Gary Philpot, famous radio preacher. A remarkable new religious feature was provided this year, when on Thursday morning, under the masterful exhortation of Dr. T. P. Duhart, sixteen young people made the decision to Stand Up and be counted for Christ. This was undoubtedly the climax of the many highlights of this convention.

Too much praise can not be given President Elder, Dr. G. F. Madkins, for the efforts he has put forth to make this the outstanding district in the Conference. Within two years, he has increased the churches from 35 to 50, money raised has more than doubled, the educational standards of the superintendents, pastors, supply ministers and other workers have risen to such an extent that the district is liberally covered with Masters, bachelors and Ph.
