SCHOLARSHIP EXAMINATIONS TO BE HELD

DURHAM (AND) — Competitive examinations for some 16 scholarships, sponsored by the James E. Shepard Memorial Foundation, will be given at North Carolina College here, April 11. It was announced this week.

Dr. A. E. Manley, chairman of the Scholarship Committee, said the foundation expects the number of candidates to exceed the 90 who competed last year.

This is only the second year that scholarships have been offered. Some 15 students from several state high schools now are enrolled at NCC under grant from the foundation. The scholarships are named for the late founder and first president of the college who died in 1917.

Meanwhile, the college announces that Miss Ruth G. Brink, former of candidates at NCC, has been named to succeed Dr. Manley, who will become president of Spelman college in Atlanta, Ga. July 1.
