The note was signed with three X's.

The cross turned out to be a crudely constructed affair measuring about four feet by 2 and a half and made of green lumber. A bottle of gasoline evidently used to set the Klan symbol ablaze was found nearby buried by the note.

Investigating police officers say that a downpour of rain which followed the ignition of the cross tended to erase any footprints etc. which might have been left at the scene. The timeworn cliché was not not in evidence when officers arrived to make the investigation. It was learned.
