HAMPTON, Va. — On their home courts, the Hampton Institute Pirates smashed Virginia Union 6-0 on April 22 and dealt Howard University some of the same medicine by defeating the Elisons 5-0.

In the match with Virginia Union, the Pirates took the first two sets of each match in the singles. Robert Martin defeated Miles Fisher of Union 6-0, 6-0. John Midda defeated Daniel Henderson of Union 6-1, 6-0. Eric Black defeated Richard Johnson 6-0, 6-0, and Theodore Megginson, Albert Fisher 6-0, 6-0.

In the doubles, Pirate Theodore Megginson teamed up with Eric Elise to win over Albert Fisher and Richard Johnson 6-1, 6-0, while John Midda and Robert Martin defeated Daniel Henderson and Miles Fisher 6-2, 6-1.

On April 25 the Pirates had to last

beat a bit harder for their victory over Howard. The Elisons took two matches but the Pirates won 5.

In the singles, Hampton grabbed four wins, 6-1 gave the last 4-0, led by Howard. Pirate single victors came when Robert Martin defeated Howard's Addison Edmondson 6-0, 6-1. John Midda, Eric Simmons, 6-2, 6-1, and Theodore Megginson, Edward Cherry, 6-3, 5-6.

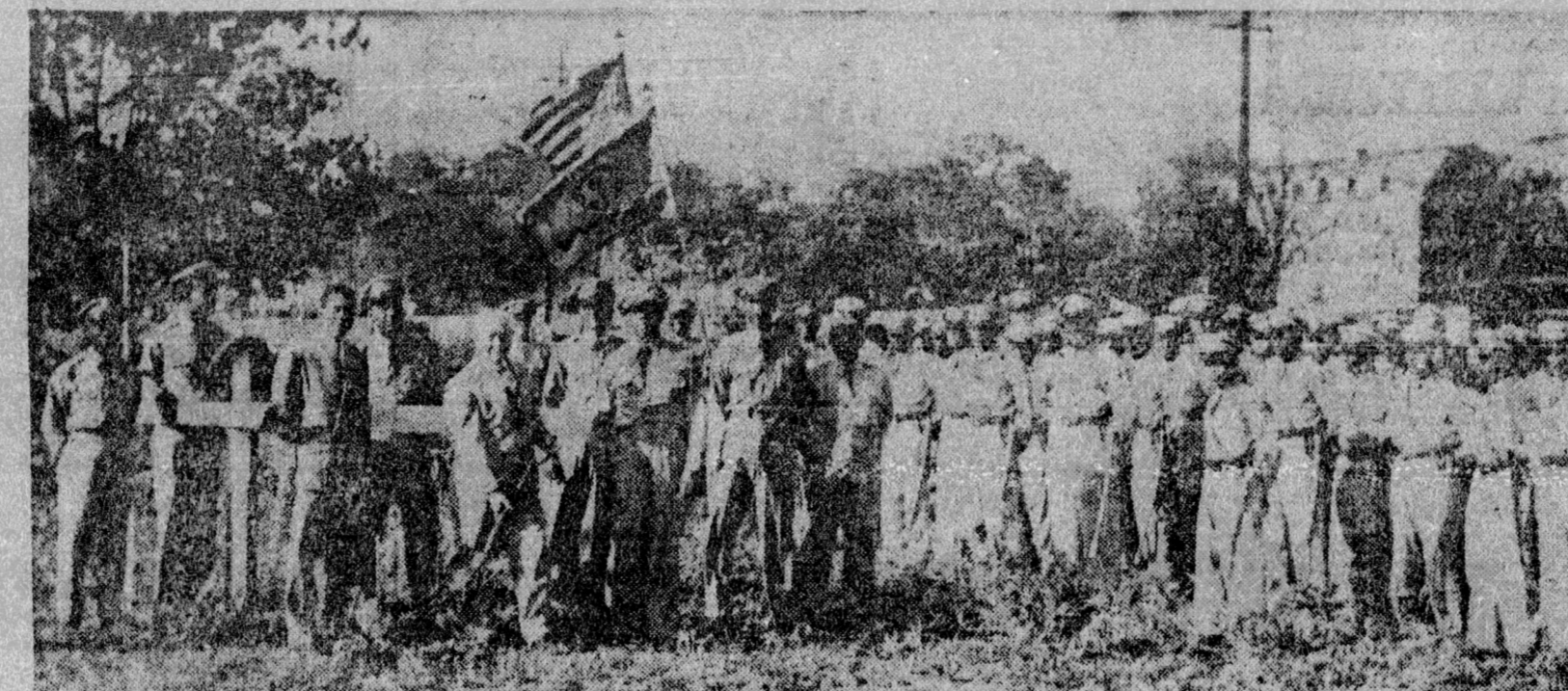

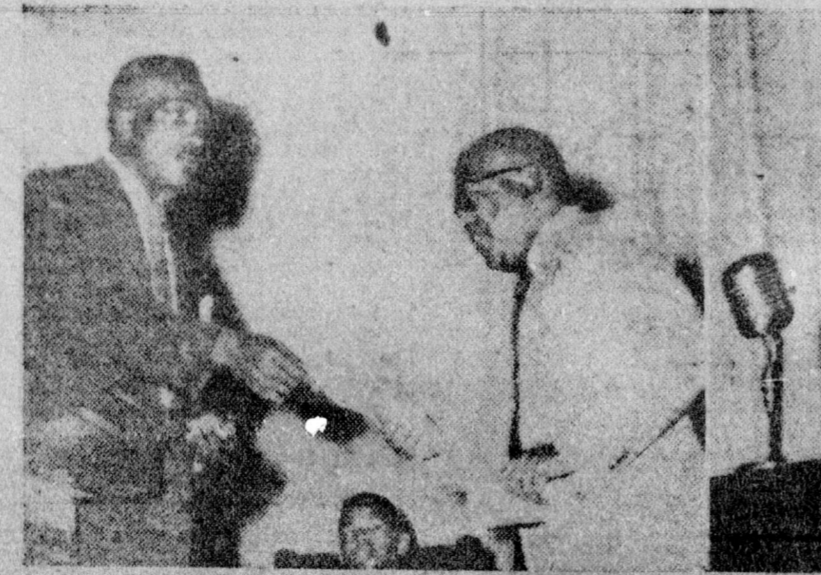

Teeth Care Is Taught Early

How to brush teeth correctly should be taught your children early in life. There are four simple steps, according to the makers of Pepsodent toothpaste. Make a game of them and your child will enjoy learning this important health habit. Teach these rules:

1. Clean the inside and outside surfaces of the upper and lower back teeth by repeatedly rolling the bristles of the brush firmly over the gums and teeth toward the grinding surfaces, reaching all teeth.
2. Repeat the same procedure on the outside surfaces of the upper and lower front teeth. It is important here as in all positions to reach all tooth areas by rolling bristles into grooves and spaces.
3. Clean the inside surfaces of the upper and lower front teeth, drawing the brush forward from gum line to biting edges. Spend same amount of brushing time on each tooth so all are cleaned equally.
4. Clean the grinding surfaces by forcing the bristles well into the grooves vibrating brush backward, forward, sideways. Before you finish, make sure you have brushed every surface of every tooth.
