



## Hot Springs Releases Race Hurler; Pitcher May Sue The Conference

HOT SPRINGS, ARK. (AP)—Hot Springs, playing at home, pitcher Jim Tugerson may file a suit against the Cotton States team because he was forced to forfeit a game 9-0 civil suit against the Cotton States to the Jackson, Miss., team because Class C League and its president, the home nine listed Tugerson on Al Haraway of Helena, Ark., in the roster and attempted to let his threat to sue come as a tie-ham pitch Wednesday night. May 20, of his being forced to the 21. President Haraway ordered the second time this baseball season to leave the Hot Springs bathers of racial prejudice.

Some 1,500 fans booed and jeered as Hot Springs' general

manager Joe Thomas read Haraway's order.

Declaring that Hot Springs by taking Tugerson back after sending him down to the Knoxville team in a Class D loop had violated an agreement reached in Greenville, Miss., on April 14, Haraway said Hot Springs would be forced to forfeit every game it played as long as Tugerson remained with the team.

As a result of this threat the bathers, languishing in last place in the Cotton States league, were forced once more to send Tugerson to Knoxville. It is also reported that Lewis Goltz, co-owner of the team and man who led the fight to break down the racial barrier in the loop, has resigned from the Hot Springs team and had his stock transferred.

After a meeting, Thursday, Haraway is reported as saying, "The Hot Springs matter has cleared itself up."

If Goltz is out, and Haraway's statement is true this means it is not likely that either Jim Tugerson or his brother, Leander, will play with Hot Springs this season. The brothers were sent to Knoxville in the Mountain States league at the beginning of the season when their presence with Hot Springs threatened to break up the Cotton States league.

With Knoxville, Jim Tugerson had compiled a 6-2 record before recalled. Hot Springs said it needed more pitching strength to rise out of the cellar. Of the whole situation Tugerson commented that there were several Cubans in the league.


