**Warren Selection May Be Civil Rights Gain**

WASHINGTON, D.C., President Eisenhower's appointment of Justice Earl Warren of California as the 14th Chief Justice of the United States has caused some observers here to believe the appointment will serve to stimulate gains on the civil rights front.

Justice Warren is considered one of the most liberal of the present Justices. He is believed to have an uncompromising position on civil rights, especially racial matters.

One informed associate of Mr. Warren's, General Herbert Brownell, is understood to have recommended Mr. Warren as the best person to handle the question of the equality of all Americans in the eyes of the law.

In California, Mr. Warren acted promptly to end discrimination against Mexican schools in San Francisco. However, his political opponents on the right say the senator took the only step open to him after a U.S. Circuit Court ruled against integration.

The Justice Department and Congress are expected to pass legislation that will give the president more power to remove army, navy, air force, and coast guard officers and personnel.

In San Francisco and Oakland as well as in the San Bay area in California, Gov. Warren's closest political ally with Negro groups was Douglas W. Lee, Oakland, former U.S. attorney in California's football scandal.

Lee was elected to the position of mayor of San Francisco in 1952. He is a member of the California State Board of Supervisors, is serving as a member of the American Bar Association, and has received several national decorations from his native state. They are in the military, the police, and the fire departments.

Lee has been active in the fight against racial discrimination. He has been instrumental in the case of the "Brown" children, who were denied admission to the public schools in Topeka, Kan.

The speaker's address is remarkably enlightening and should be heard by the people of Raleigh.
