Mr. Williams gave his all to the campaign and it is a debt of honor owed to the Negro people of Raleigh and the city at large but abandoned by all including those who opposed his aims and policies.

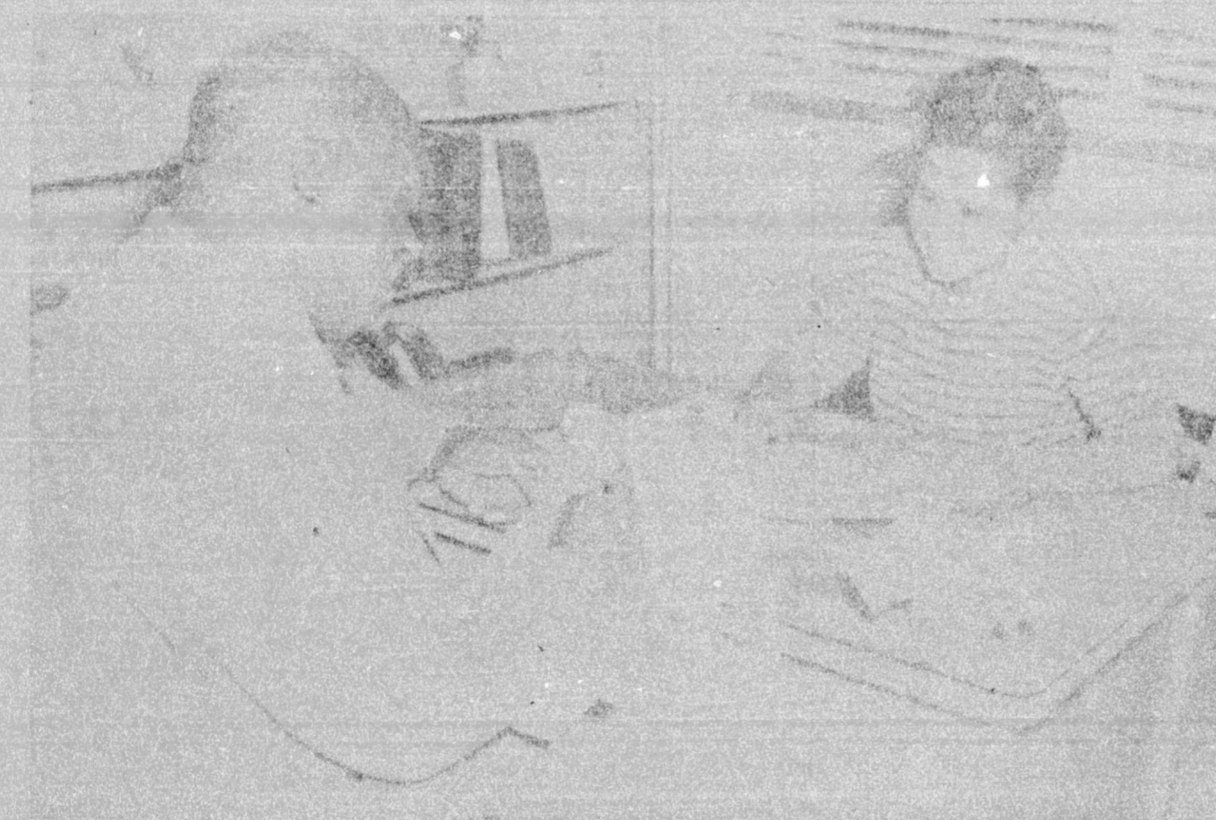
