W. J. Kennedy, President North Carolina Mutual Life Insurance Co., will deliver the principal address. Others who are scheduled to take part are D. A. Oglesby, Rev. J. H. Wilson, Aberdeen; C. A. Dillon, chairman, N. C. State Board of Correction and Training; E. L. Hauser, Superintendent of Public Welfare; James T. Taylor, Durham; Robert Murphy, former student and Mr. Larkin. The buildings are named as follows: The Thad Tate Building named in honor of the man who started the movement. He is known to have become interested in such a program when he befriended a small boy in his hometown of Charlotte. He will be remembered as an outstanding barber in the queen city.

The Annie K. Best Building is a tribute to Mrs. Annie K. Best, who served as Commissioner for 14 years. The P. R. and Josephine Brown Building is named for the present director of the school and his wife. They have both served since 1941. The D. S. Coltrane Building is named in honor of the present assistant director of the budget bureau. The S. E. Leonard Building is named for S. E. Leonard who is Commissioner, State Board of Correction and Training.

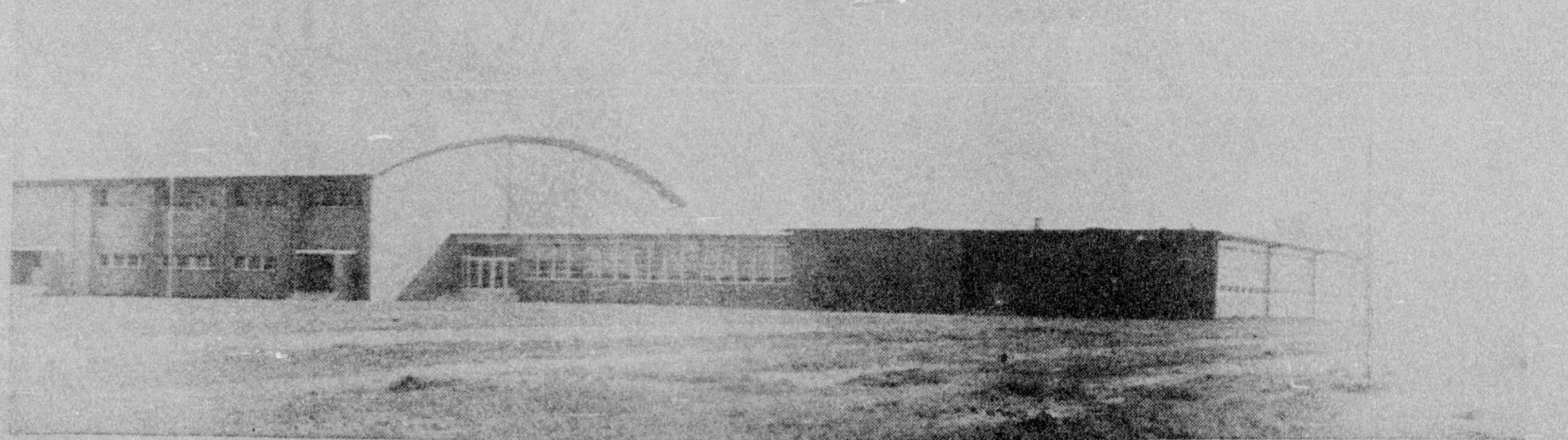
