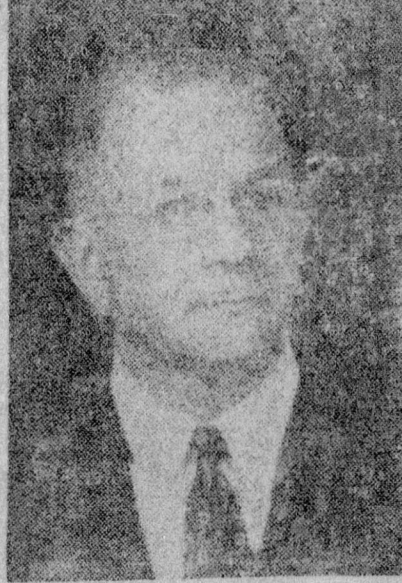

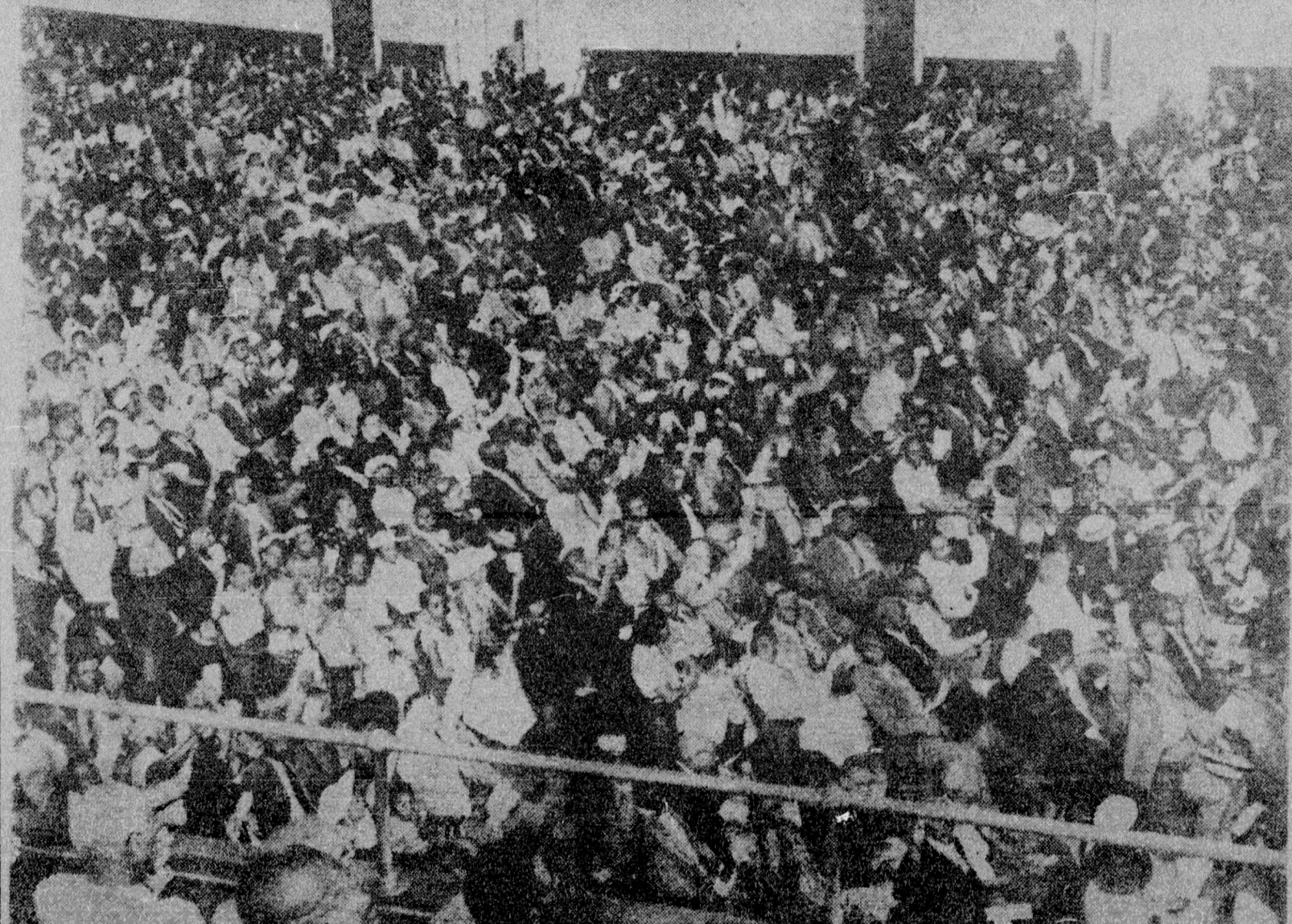

500 Schools Mixed Since Court Ruling

NEW YORK (AP)—Despite the efforts of racists and agitators who are trying to sabotage the U. S. Supreme court decision banning segregation in education, integration of the nation's schools is quietly succeeding. This progress was confirmed by results of a study by the NAACP which showed that in the 12 months following the historic court decision, nearly 250,000 Negro and white children are attending classes peaceably together in 500 public elementary and secondary schools which until last year, had been for the exclusive use of boys and girls of one race or the other.
