### Raleigh Man Stabbed To Death In A Church Yard

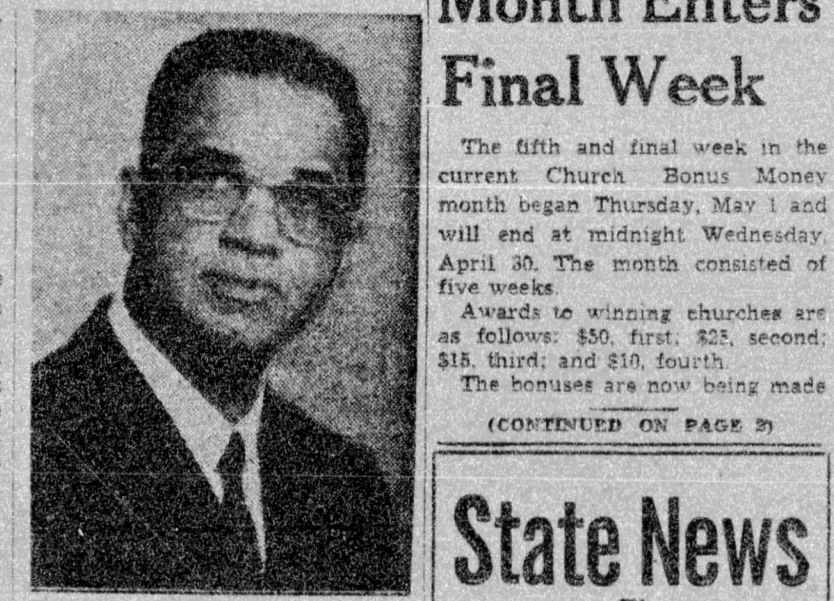
