

"You Can't Play It Safe" Says Bishop

GREENSBORO — "The world in which we live is too dangerous for anything but the truth and too small for anything other than brotherhood," Bishop John Lord declared in his Founders' Day address at Bennett College Sunday.

Bishop Lord, who presides over the Washington Area of the Methodist Church, chose as his subject, "The World Has Need of You."

Pointing out that large segments of the adult population are suffering from a fear of the world in which they live, Bishop Lord stated that the true function of the college today is to shed its light into the dark places of the world that the fear-ridden and lost may find the clue to the universe.

"Humanity," he said, "stands in desperate need of those who can be interpreters of the hour through which we are passing. There are two things which you can do on behalf of humanity. First, be willing to become involved. You can't play it safe in a world like this. Secondly, you must be willing to accept the disciplined life. No man is free until he has voluntarily disciplined his own life."

In a direct appeal to the students, Bishop Lord reminded them that without continuous study, their earned academic degrees will decrease in value each year and that they should be prepared to give back to the world "manners, virtue, freedom and power."

Allen President To Speak At NCC

DURHAM — Dr. Howard E. Wright, president of Allen University, Columbia, S. C., and a former professor and head of North Carolina College's psychology department, will be the principal speaker at the NCC forum assembly Monday, Nov. 12, at 10 a. m. in the B. N. Duke Auditorium.

Well-known in North Carolina educational and civic circles, Dr. Wright has taught at North Carolina College on two occasions — from 1945 to 1948, and from 1953 to 1961. Prior to his first employment at the college, he taught at Albany State College, Albany, Ga., and Prairie View State College, Prairie View, Tex. Leaving NCC in 1948, he served as chairman of the education division at Texas Southern University, Houston, where he remained five years, re-

turning to Durham in 1953 and remaining until 1961, when he accepted the presidency of Allen University. He is the first layman to head the college, which is under the auspices of the African Methodist Episcopal Church.
