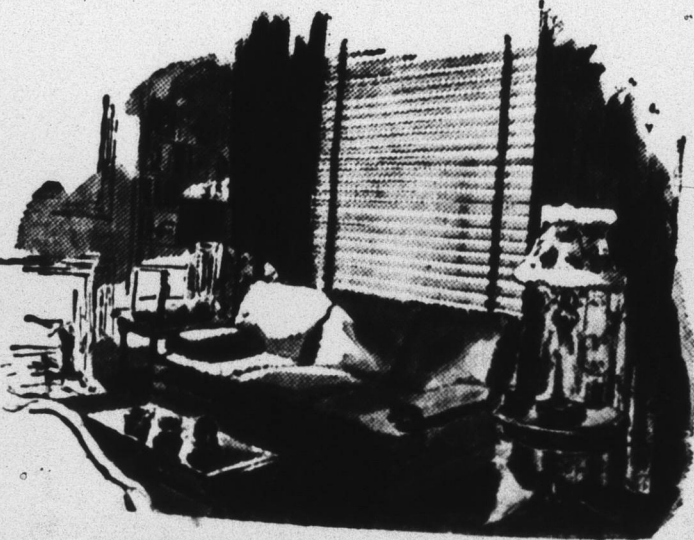

LEARNING A LANGUAGE

When it comes to learning a language, we think of two ways. The usual one, in the case of a person's mother tongue, is through hearing it spoken continuously and by imitation. However, there is another way of learning a language, and a more scientific method, is through a detailed study of each sound in the language, the grammar and syntax.

Because deaf people can't hear, or their hearing acuity is reduced, they do not learn to speak, or they experience much difficulty in learning to speak.

Parents who have hard-of-hearing children, or deaf children, should enroll them in a preschool class for the deaf. There are, however, hundreds of cities and towns that do not have such classes or centers for the instruction of the deaf child.

For parents of these children, I recommend a book, "Language for the Preschool Deaf Child," by Grace Lassman, published by Grune and Stratton, New York City. This book costs \$5.95.

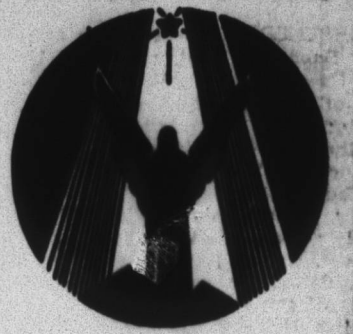
