Stabs Wife To Death; Says Mom-In-Law Took Her Away

GREENWOOD, Miss. (ANP) — Winston Gordon, 24, is accused of the fatal stabbing of his young wife because his mother-in-law had "taken her away from me."

Police said Gordon admitted plunging a "crab apple switch blade knife" into the heart of Mrs. Martha Jean Gordon, 21, at her home. He was charged with murder.

Officers said the distraught husband went to the home, where his mate and their children were living, and broke open the front door with a brick and entered. Gordon told police he took the knife from his wife and stabbed her.
