Equal Treatment Of All Americans Stressed By Norman Paul At Shaw

The Honorable Norman S. Paul, Assistant Secretary of Defense (manpower) told Shaw University students last Friday that his department, along with the rest of the Federal Government, has as its goal the peaceful achievement of equal treatment of all Americans on their merits as individuals. One of the essential parts of that overall goal, he stated, is the opportunity to secure a job for which one is personally qualified, and to advance upward as far as one's talents warrant, without having extraneous factors influence either the obtaining of the job or the speed of advancement thereafter.

LONDON, England (ANP)—Ghanaian and British Empire featherweight champion Floyd Robertson, will get his long-sought shot at the world title when he fights champion Sugar Ramos of Cuba in Accra, Ghana, on May 2. British promoter Jack Solomons announced here last week.

The promoter also disclosed that another black African boxer might also soon get a chance to fight for the title. The prospective African title challenger is Nigerian featherweight champion Joe Rafiu King. Solomons said he has arranged for Ramos to defend his title against the winner of a March 24 bout between King and European titlist Howard Winston. Should Sugar retain his title against Robertson.
