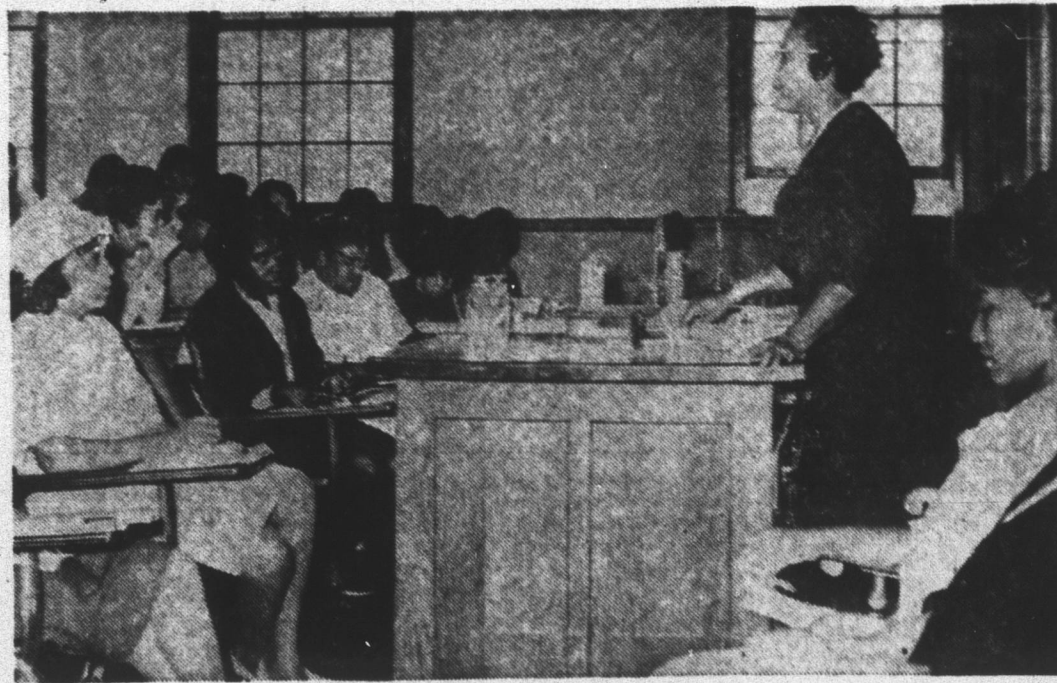


## Cops Raid Heroin 'Shooting Gallery' And Arrest Eight

CLEVELAND (AP)—Narcotics detectives raided an apartment here last week and said they surprised two operators of a heroin "shooting gallery" administering dope to three men and three women. Altogether, eight East Side men and women were charged with violating Ohio narcotic laws. Accused of operating the "gallery" were Ronnie Cross, 34, and Christine Jones, 24. 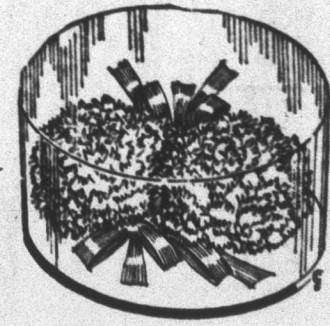

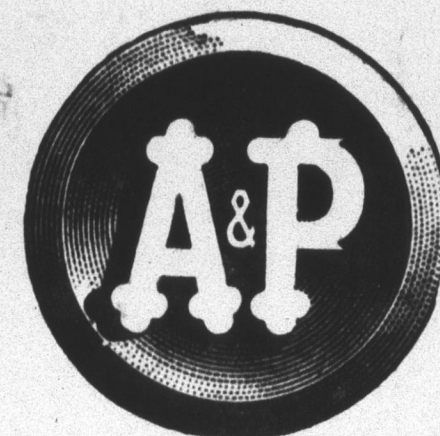
