**History Of A&T College Is Printed**

GREENSBORO — The first history of A&T College, authored by Mrs. Carrye Hill Kelley, was released by the printers last week. The production, in booklet form, is a concentrated version of the original, complete history written by Mrs. Kelley three years ago. Besides tracing the development of the college from its founding back in 1891, the book gives vivid accounts of interesting experiences in the lives of the five men who served as its heads. The list includes: Dr. John O. Crosby, Dr. James B. Dudley, Dr. Ferdinand D. Bluford, Dr. Warmoth T. Gibbs, and Dr. Samuel D. Proctor, and a brief biographical sketch on Dr. Lewis C. Dowdy who assumed the presidency last April, 1964. The book is illustrated. The author, a graduate of A&T College holds master of arts degree from both the University of Pennsylvania and New York University. She serves at the college as associate professor of English.

**J. Brown To Make Film Debut**

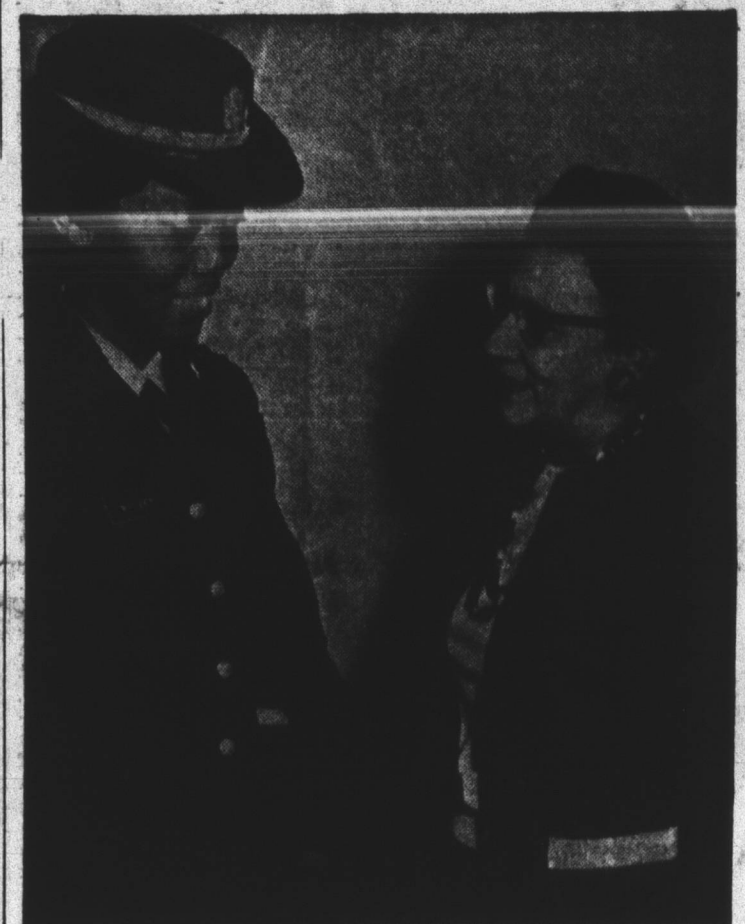
