It is wonderful what a capacity things that we consider urgent have for "keeping," if one is only selfcontained and patient e nough to let them "keep." One of the Emost successful business men we have ever known was famous for his refusal to give immediate decisions upon important ques tions. He said to those who treed him that he had "to sleep over" things before he made up his mind. That did not mean that he took them home to worry about them, but, that he let them lie in his mird and germinate before he would decide just what he would do. At least, he gained the advantage of looking at the matter from several different points of view. And the point of view frequently changes the whole aspect of a situation. The men who are in such a drive and hurry that they must for year 1896, tax and cost make up their minds "right 2.92. away" turn up with unusual frequency in the bankruptcy courts. There is nothing lost by following the sound maxim. "If you don't know and cost what to do, do nothing" .-




