To those outside the State there has been nothing more surprising in all the country than the revulsion of feeling in South Carolina against the dispensary system, as made manifest in the result of the county elections on the question in the last six months. We do not know how many counties have vo ted on it-at a rough guess five or six - but in every case the result has been adverse to the dispensary; it has been voted out in behalf of prohibition. The result in Ma rion county Tuesday m u s have astonished the South Carolinians themselves. In reference to it the Columbia State says in a double-lead ed editorial:

"The overwhelming defeat of the dispensary in Marion yesterday should enable the most blind to understand the handwriting upon the wall. It has been clearly translated. The unbelievers might have doubted the sentiment in South Carolina when only counties in the piedmont had spoken, but when fourteen of the chief precincts in Marion, heretefore the strongest dis pensary county in the Pee Dee section or the State, recorded a vote of 1,008 ag ainst the dispensary to 215 for the dispensary, there can be no further doubt. Senator Tillman spoke in Marion on last Saturday and pleaded for the retention of the dispensary.
