 Because President Truman has signed a bill which merely added the letter "S" to another bill, fifteen Post Office employees will get \$400-a-year raises. Federal loan agencies were financing almost three-fourths of North Carolina's farm mortgage debt in 1940. By 1950 private lenders had again become the main source of farm credit.

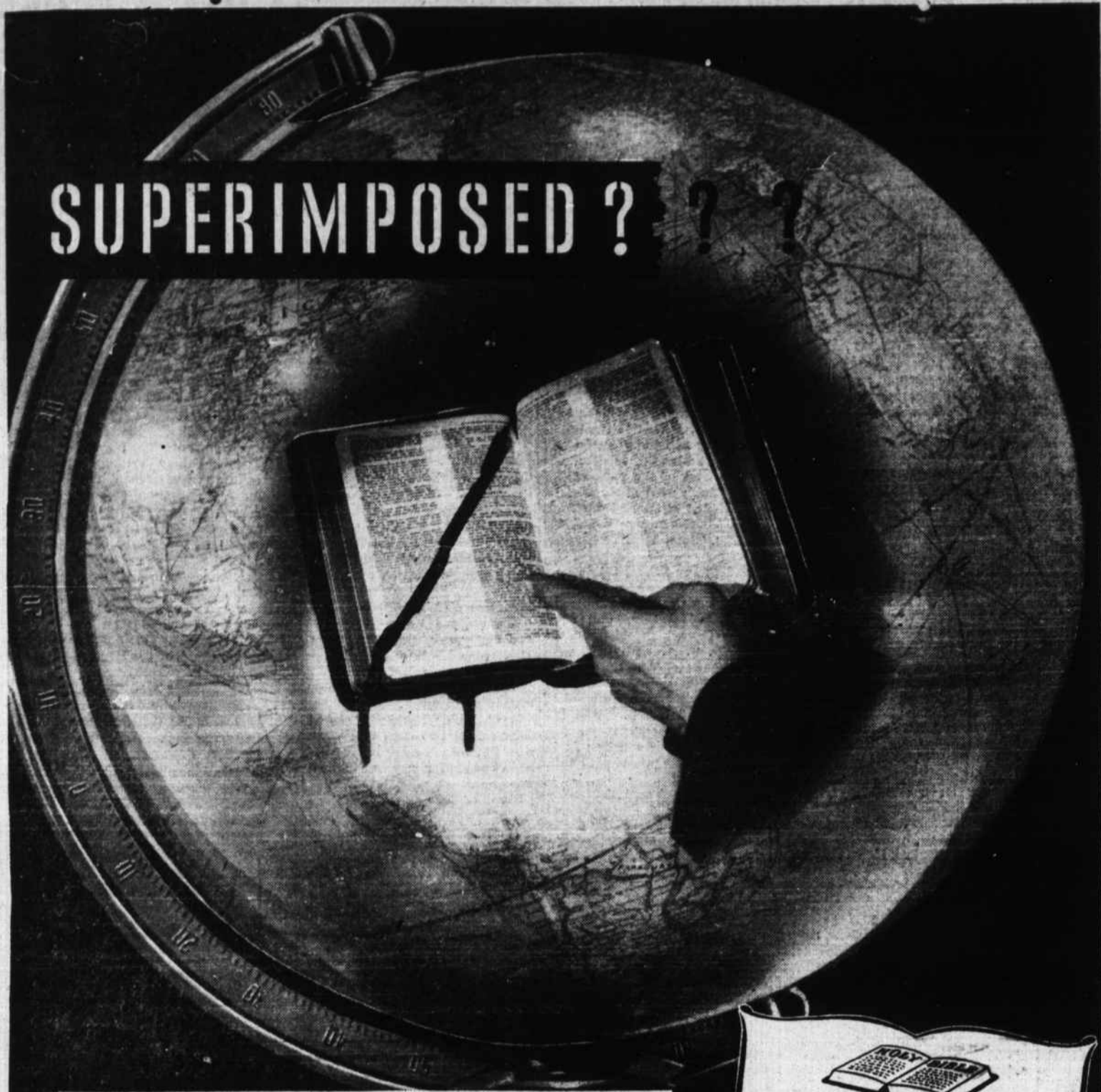
