Mr. G. W. Edwards, president of Skyline Telephone Membership Corp., announced today that the construction of the new telephone system in this county is progressing rapidly. He explained that all of the cable is in place and the crews are rapidly pulling in the open wire.

Mr. Edwards stated that the contractor will have crews wiring houses for telephone service for the next few weeks and pointed out that the people taking phones should decide exactly where they want their telephone installed in order to avoid delaying this work. Cooperation on the part of the people in this matter will be appreciated.

Mr. Edwards also stated that the people who have not paid the balance of their membership fee should do so immediately. The new system is scheduled to be cut into operation on August 18.
