"Many area clergymen have an important decision to make by April 15," Don W. Marsh, social security district manager in Hickory, said today.

The 1965 amendments to the social security law gave clergymen who had missed out on previous opportunities to sign up for social security coverage another chance to elect this protection. Now this latest "open season" provided by law is about to run out, he said.

"I urge clergymen who have any doubts about their present coverage or questions about coverage for past or for future years to get in touch with their social security office without delay. The time is short. And much may be at stake for clergymen and their dependents," the district manager said.

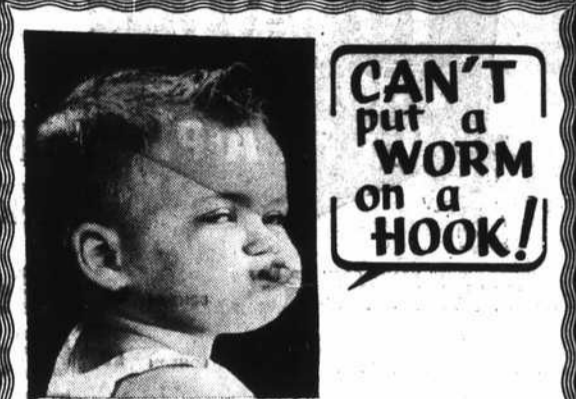

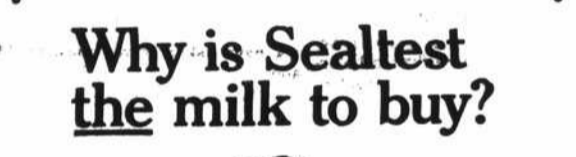
