ON POSTAL CRIMES The Post Office Department has reported that postal inspectors arrested 13,734 people including 996 employees in the year just ended. He added that new detection systems and improved security devices were being installed.

ON SOCIAL SECURITY The House has voted for a raise in benefits to 24.2 million Social Security recipients. No increase in payroll tax is planned, at present, but the tax would be applied to salaries up to \$7,600.
