Here's A Tasty Holiday Tea

PIN-BALL TEA PUNCH

- 2 quarts freshly drawn cold water 1/4 cup loose tea, 15 tea-bags or 5 tablespoons instant tea
- cup sugar cup water 2-inch cinnamon sticks
- tablespoon grated lemon rind
- 1/2 cup orange juice 1/4 cup lemon juice

1/2 cup pineapple juice For tea leaves or teabags, bring two quarts of water to a full rolling boil. Pour over tea,

cover and let brew 3 to 5 min-utes; strain. For instant tea, merely dissolve in cold water. Combine sugar, 1 cup water, cinnamon and fruit rinds. Simmer 15 minutes, Addsyrup and fruit juices to tea and chill thoroughly. Serve in punch bowl over ice cubes, or make pretty ice ring like this: Arrange seasonal or well drained frozen or canned fruit in a shallow or canned fruit in a shallow layer of water in the bottom of the ring mold or angel food cake pan. Put in freezer until fruit pattern is frozen in place. Add more ice water and return to freezer until entire ring is solid. Unmold by running a little water over bottom of pan.

Quick Recipe For Yule Egg Nog

eggs, separated cup sugar cups cream

Beat egg yolks and sugar until thick and lemon colored. Beat in cream, milk, salt and vanilla. Beat egg whites until they hold stiff peaks; fold into egg yolk mixture. Serve in chilled punch bowl — sprinkle nutmeg on top.
