Dr. Jellicorse Is Given Honor At Northwestern U

Students at Northwestern University in Evanston, Ill., have named Dr. John Lee Jellicorse as one of the 25 most outstanding faculty members at that institution.

Dr. Jellicorse, recently promoted to the rank of Associate Professor of Public Address and Group Communication, received the award at Honors Day at Northwestern May 19. He was one of the first 25 faculty members chosen for the "Faculty Honor Roll" established this year by the Northwestern Student Senate to honor those faculty members "who, in the eyes of the Student Body, most deserve recognition for the role that they have played as scholars, educators, and leaders."

Dr. Jellicorse is married to the former Mary Lawrence, daughter of Dr. C. Ray Lawrence of Boone. Dr. and Mrs. Jellicorse met while both were acting in Horn in the West, he in the lead role of Jeffrey Stuart, she in the role of Nancy Ward. Dr. Jellicorse taught at Appalachian State University during the summers of 1961 and 1962. They will spend the summer in Knoxville, Tenn., while Dr. Jellicorse does research on a \$2,000 Summer Fellowship Grant awarded him by Northwestern.

Dr. Jellicorse teaches two courses each quarter at Northwestern, including sophomore courses in persuasion and speech composition, senior courses in the history of American public address, and advanced seminars in speech historiography and persuasion. He is chairman of the School of Speech Undergraduate Studies
