### Five Are Given Scholarships At Appalachian

Five high school seniors from western North Carolina have been selected to receive \$500 James G. K. McClure Fund scholarships for study during the next academic year at Appalachian State University.

The Scholarship Committee of the McClure Educational and Development Fund announced this week that the awards will go to Claude L. Hughes III of Newland; Judith Lorraine Miller of Laurel Springs; Vickie Caren Phillips of Spruce Pine; and Martha Kay Moretz and Martha Mays Young, both of Boone.

The objective of the scholarship program of the McClure Fund is to aid financially deserving and academically promising residents of the 22-county area of western North Carolina to pursue their formal educations beyond high school. Candidates were recommended by the university.

In the choice of scholarship recipients, the following factors were considered: high school record for both scholarship and leadership, evidence of Christian character, financial need, intellectual promise and demonstrated ambition.

The scholarship awards are conditioned upon the holder's doing academic work acceptable to Appalachian State University and to the McClure Fund.

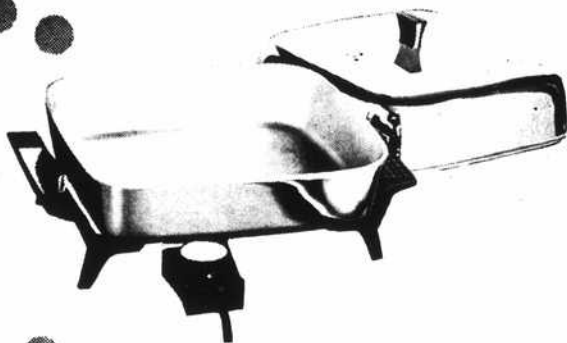
The summer theatre is to be entirely supported by box office sales.
