The Scholarship Committee of the McClure Educational and Development Fund announced this week that the awards will go to Claude L. Hughes III of Newland; Judith Lorraine Miller of Laurel Springs; Vickie Caren Phillips of Spruce Pine; and Martha Kay Moretz and Martha Mays Young, both of Boone.

The objective of the scholar-ship program of the McClure Fund is to aid financially deserving and academically prom-ising residents of the 22-county area of western North Carolina to pursue their formal educations beyond high school, Candidates were recommended by the university.


