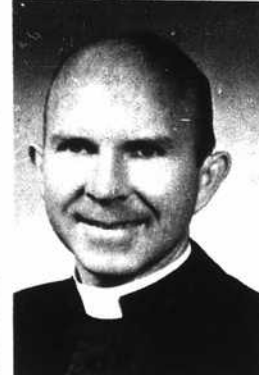

## Lutherans In Watauga Join In Program Of Evangelism

Lutherans in Watauga County will join a synod-wide program of Evangelism Missions beginning Wednesday, Oct. 23, and concluding Sunday, Oct. 27. The congregations of Bethany, Grace and Holy Communion Lutheran churches will hold separate but similar missions using the theme, Christian Living in A Changing World. During that week the five services at Bethany will be conducted by the Rev. Richard B. Dorton, pastor of St. Enoch Lutheran Church in Kannapolis. The Rev. Hoke H. Ritchie of Grace Lutheran Church, Thomasville, will preach at Grace and the Rev. Harold L. McSwain of Luther's Lutheran Church, Richfield, will be guest missionary at the Holy Communion Lutheran Church. The Wednesday through Saturday services will begin at 7:30 p. m. in each church with the final Evangelical Mission Service to be given at the 11

o'clock worship services Sunday morning. The theme Wednesday night will be "The Changeless God"; Thursday, "The Changing World"; while Friday's theme is "The Changing Church". "Caught In The Squeeze" will be the theme of a special youth-parents' night on Saturday. Grace and Holy Communion churches will have 6 p. m. suppers Saturday. At Bethany, which celebrates its homecoming that weekend, a picnic will be held at noon after the Sunday service. "Partners In The Midst of Change" will be the theme of the Sunday morning services. Joining the missionaries in the services will be the host pastors, the Rev. Gilbert Goodman of Bethany, the Rev. David R. Keck of Grace and the Rev. Larry Campbell of Holy Communion. Visitors are welcome to participate in any of the services, which are designed to foster better understanding of Christian living in a changing world.

The Rev. Hoke Ritchie also is known in Watauga, having served from 1944-46 as pastor of Holy Trinity, Mt. Pleasant, Mt. Zion and Old Mt. Pleasant Lutheran churches. Graduating from Lenoir Rhyne in 1941 and from the Lutheran Southern Seminary, Columbia, S. C., in 1944, Pastor Ritchie served the Daniels, Lincolnton, Grace (Newton, 1946-51) and Trinity (Rocky Mount, 1951-66) congregations in addition to Watauga and his present Thomasville church. He is a member of the Executive Board of the N. C. Lutheran Synod, president of the Thomasville Ministerial Association and Chaplain and member of the Thomasville Civitan Club. He formerly served on the Board of Southern Seminary and was statistician of the N. C. Lutheran Synod. Married to Eunice Cook, he is the father of four.
