### Battens Will Hide V-Joints on Wall

If living room walls in your house are paneled with V-joint boards and that Colonial pattern simply isn't your cup of tea, why not remodel the wall?

For a boldly modern effect, nail battens over the joints between panel boards. Use a two-inch-wide batten if the V-joint boards are eight inches wide, and a one-inch batten for narrower paneling.

Finishing can be dramatic with dark stained battens applied over boards finished clear or painted white, putty or a subtle antique gold. But finishing battens and panel boards to match is highly effective, too.
