Commenting on the problem of emphysema. Thomas said, "Emphysema has become a hopeless and frustrating disease in the minds of patients and physicians as well. Christmas Seals mean hope and help to many in maintaining the breath of life."

In addition to detection activities, the funds are used also to carry on educational activities and to help patients during treatment, Rehabilitation is stressed so each patient may return to his job and become a productive citizen, Thomas said.

The Watauga campaign will be the first since the county merged with eight other counties to become the Northwestern Tuberculosis and Respiratory Disease Association, The main effice is in Winston-Salem, One of the association's first projects will be to purchase an X-ray unit for the district health department of Ashe, Alleghany and Watauga counties, Christmas Seal funds left in the account of the old AAW County TB Association have been provided to share in the purchase of the X-ray unit.

When the X-ray facilities are available, the Northwestern TB and RD Association hopes to begin a regularly scheduled pro-

gram of pulmonary function testing here. The breathing test indicate whether a person can move the air as easily as he should. The test is helpful in the prevention of emphyseria and chronic bronchitis.

Many times before the victim's illness comes to the attention of a physician, the disease process may be quite far advanced, causing permanent disability, the economic disaster of high medical costs, plus the inability to work.

In many instances the chronic bronchitis is complicated by the development of alergies and recurrent acute bacterial lung infections. In severe cases, the long standing and progressive damage to lungs may result in severe strain on the heart with resulting heart failure.

North Carolina has the sec-ond highest percentage in-crease (both in number of deaths and death rates per 100,-000) of deaths from emphysema and chronic bronchitis of the 50 states, At this time, doctors do not know how to prevent emphyse-ma, But medical treatment can allow down the progress of em-physema if the patient is treat-ed early.
