It seems strange that almost at the same moment that the House of Representatives approved another pay increase for federal employes President Nixon told leaders of business and labor they must display wage-price restraints,

In a letter sent to 2,200 business and or union officials appealing for their help fighting inflation, the President wrote:

"The danger of inflation is real, The cure requires some unpleasant medicine, patience on the part of all, and self-discipline by government, business and labor."

The federal pay increase, if approved by the Senate and signed by the President, would add 1,5 billion dollars to the federal payroll for the balance of this fiscal year and would coast an additional 4,5 billion in subsequent

That provision was defeated but the pay hike, in view of Mr. Nixon's warring to labor and industry that the cure for inflation calls for "patience on the part of all and self-discipline by government, pusiness and labor," needs a hard look if government is soing to give more than lip service to the very real problem of inflation.
