

John H. Harrell Dies From Heart Attack

Prominent Farmer Falls Dead on Porch at Home

John Henry Harrell, prominent farmer of the Yeopim section, died suddenly of a heart attack at his home about 3:30 o'clock Monday afternoon. Mr. Harrell was about his regular duties and had come to the house, when he fell dead on the back porch of his home.

Deceased, a native of Chowan County, was 68 years old, a son of the late Thomas A. and Sarah Evans Harrell. He was a member of the Yeopim Baptist Church and a long time member of the Chowan Tribe of Red Men.

Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Lillie W. Harrell; a son, Thomas Harrell; and three daughters, Miss Sarah Margaret Harrell of Edenton, Mrs. Roy Beach of Hamilton, N. C., and Mrs. Lewis Thomas of Portsmouth, Va. Four sisters, Mrs. W. E. Hassell and Mrs. C. N. Griffin of Edenton and Mrs. Olivia Hobbs and Mrs. Charles E. Johnson of Hertford, and five grandchildren also survive.

Funeral services were held at the home Wednesday afternoon at 3 o'clock, with W. J. Berryman officiating, assisted by the Rev. W. C. Francis. Interment was made in Beaver Hill Cemetery.
