Broad Bay Manor
Broad Bay Manor, home of Mr. and Mrs. John B. Dey, is in the Great Neck Section of Princess Anne County. The land grant dates back to 1636, while that part of the State still was a part of Elizabeth City Shire. The original residence, part of which still stands, is reputed to have been built by Thomas Allen in 1640. It contains a large fireplace with warming closets in each end. The room also contains a part of the original winding stairway. The main

house commands a fine view of Broad Bay, and is surrounded by age-old boxwood bushes, sweeping lawns and broad fields. Both house and gardens will be open.

White Acre

White Acre is the home of Mrs. B. D. White, in Princess Anne County. The gardens are bordered by the Lynnhaven River and the handdriven juniper picket fence is from the home of Grace Sherwood, Princess Anne County's witch. The house, covered with English ivy, was built in 1848. The gardens contain many camellias and azaleas. Only the gardens will be open.

Among the modern gardens to be seen are those of Holly Lodge, North Shore Point, Algonquin Park, home of H. B. Goodridge. This is a man's garden and is an example of successful transplanting of shrubs and trees from warmer climates—camellias, azaleas, yaupon, boxwood and ancient live oaks.

Also near Norfolk are the Azalea Gardens, probably the largest and most beautiful free gardens in the country, where thousands of azaleas, camellias, rhododendron and Japanese irises are planted around the lakes.

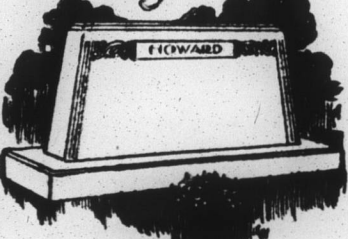
