

Farmers Plan To Observe Results Of Conservation Work

Group In Chowan Will Check on Improved Pastures

The pasture improvement and pasture establishment period has just about come to halt for this season, according to R. E. Jordan, soil conservationist of the Albemarle Soil Conservation District. Until the fall, most farmers will be most concerned with the planting and tending of the cultivated crops to be grown. In the meantime, however, those farmers of the county who carried out the pasture work as planned for in their soil conservation farm plans will take time out to observe the results of their efforts. Those farmers to whom assistance was given, either directly or indirectly, in the improvement of old pastures or the establishment of new pastures were: H. T. Hobbs, R. T. Harrell, E. B. Boyce, E. L. Ward, Mrs. Maebelle Winslow, J. Bertram Hollowell, Tom Asbell, McCoy Phthisic, Foy Ward, Claude Baker, Joe Wills, Willie Twine and T. C. Byrum. Other farmers who missed out on getting theirs in this spring will be assisted with this work in the coming fall or spring. Most of the above individuals were establishing new permanent pastures or renovating old pastures. Some were providing temporary pastures only for hog grazing. Still others were resorting to pastures as better land-use measures. For instance, H. T. Hobbs converted one acre of an old, idle roadbed to a permanent pasture consisting of Kobe and Korean lespedeza, Dallis Grass and white clover. C. E. Baker will retire a rapidly eroding row crop area to soil saving pasture crops. E. B. Boyce will use an acre of low land for pasture production—land which produced row crops but poorly. E. L. Ward has plans for increased pasture acreage, but is not losing sight of his need for greater production from land now in pasture. He is liming and fertilizing fields already established to permanent grazing crops, so as to be able to incorporate grasses which thrive only on soils of high fertility level. T. C. Byrum has reseeded five acres of old permanent pasture and established seven and one-half more acres in order to supply himself with approximately one acre of pasture per animal unit. "Hogs will not graze on these pastures," declares Mr. Byrum, and to prove the validity of his statement has seeded with the assistance of Charlie Hollowell, his tenant, some eleven acres of special hog-grazing crops. They believe in letting hogs root in their own rooting grounds rather than in the better treated cattle pastures. Many other Chowan County farmers should emulate these men, declares Mr. Jordan. Pastures, he asserts, offer not only an efficient, economical means of livestock feed production but an opportunity to better use certain parcels of land that may be subjected to excessive soil washing under row crop production or of little profit in idle acres.
