

Timber Subject At 4-H Club Meetings

Extension Forester Lectured Chowan Clubs Last Week

J. C. Jones, extension forester, spoke to each of Chowan County's 4-H Club groups last week, emphasizing the importance of conserving forest resources, various methods of cutting timber and explained several projects in forestry which 4-H Club members can carry out.

At three of the meetings Mr. Jones took the club boys on a short tour and showed them how to determine the age of pine trees by using an increment borer. He also showed them how to use a cruiser's stick in estimating the amount of timber in a tract. The club boys were very interested in Mr. Jones' talk and demonstration and apparently were greatly benefitted.
