

Peanuts In Section Reported Damaged

Much of Crop Suitable Only For Oil After Shelling

Very few farmers' stock peanuts were sold during the past week in the Virginia-North Carolina section, and remaining supplies of good quality suitable for edible purposes in growers' hands are light. Shellers report that much of the current offerings are damaged and after shelling are suitable only for oil purposes.

Support prices were being paid for farmers' stock except for good quality for which a premium was being paid.

The demand was good for milled products and the market was slightly stronger for jumbos, extra large, me-

diums and No. 1s and was steady for fancies.

Trade reports indicate that several large lots were sold for export to Canada during the past week and that some mills are sold up through February.

Sales and quotations f.o.b. shipping point, per lb., were reported as follows: Virginias, cleaned, jumbos, 18 1/2-19 1/2c; fancies, 14 1/2-15c; few 14 1/2c; shelled, extra large 21-21 1/2c; mediums 19-19 1/2c; few 20c; No. 1, 17-17 1/2c.
