

# '48 Graduating Class Facing Open Doors

Rev. R. N. Carroll Baccalaureate Speaker Sunday Night

Edenton High School's 1948 grad-

uating class and a large number of relatives and friends heard the Rev. R. N. Carroll, pastor of the Baptist Church, preach the baccalaureate sermon in the school auditorium Sunday night. Mr. Carroll used as his text Rev. 3:8, "I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name."

At the outset Mr. Carroll congratulated members of the class upon

their achievement, and urged them to get ready to fight the battle of life. "Up until now," he said, "you have had the aid of other hands, but now you must help yourselves." He likened the graduates to a large vessel which is towed by a tug boat to deep water, from which point the larger vessel is on its own. "Parents and teachers have launched you on life," he said, "but from now on you must help yourselves and many important questions will have to be

answered by you."

Referring to the text, Mr. Carroll said, "There are a number of open doors before you and nobody can shut them but yourselves. The door of moral achievement, the door to character, the door to a great cause and the open door of a great Christ." He stressed the need for men and women of character and integrity, saying, "Reputation is something which is made, but character grows. Reputation is what you are supposed to be, but character is what you are."

The source of Christian character is God."

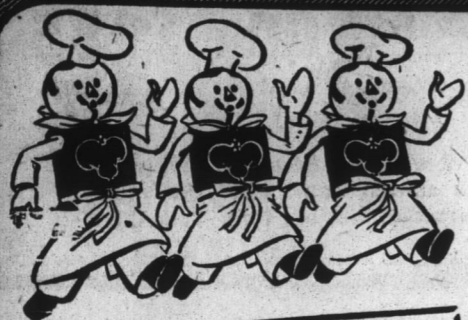
In closing, Mr. Carroll said, "Across the open door of a great Christ is the shadow of a rugged cross, and I urge you to enter this door no matter what you do in life."
