

Overman Believes Boll Weevil Control Has Been Solved

County Agent Says "Puts Profits Into Pockets Instead of Insects"

"At last we believe we have a satisfactory control for the boll weevil on cotton," says County Agent C. W. Overman. "Several insecticides are being used, but due to conditions in Chowan County, we have selected Toxaphene with 14% sulphur. This insecticide will control the boll weevil and red spider and hold down the aphid and plant lice population."

Mr. Overman stated that the time of dusting will depend upon the appearance of the boll weevil and other insects. This will be determined by field inspection. The first application

SECTION 1-A—UTILITIES BUILDING
