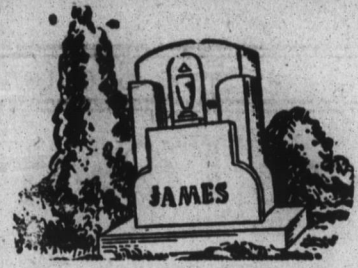
built from the ground up within the last few years and now offers one of the finest carnival aggregations on the road.
