Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Edenton that section II (d) of the "Parking Meter" ordinance adopted October 14, 1947, is amended by adding thereto the following provision: "Provided the Police Department of the Town of Edenton may, in its discretion, remit said penalty of \$1.00, and in lieu thereof shall require the owner or operator of such vehicle to deposit the sum of 5 cents in a parking meter installed at the Police Station of said Town for each hour or fraction thereof such vehicle has remained overparked; the failure of such owner or operator to make such deposit shall render such owner or operator subject to the penalties hereinafter provided for violation of the provisions of this ordinance."

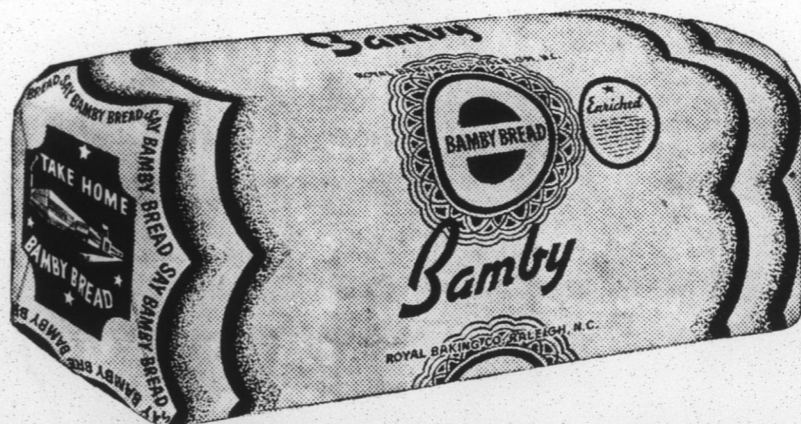

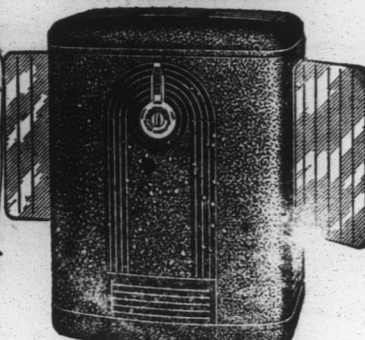
