

Support Prices For Peanuts Released

J. M. Price Reminds Producers of CCC 1948 Program

J. M. Price, secretary of the Chowan Agricultural Conservation Association, announced this week that the support price for farmers' stock peanuts grading 65 per cent sound mature kernels is \$207 per ton, or 10.35 cents per pound. This is the base grade and price. Peanuts grading better than 65 per cent are supported at a price above \$207 per ton and grades lower than 65 per cent are supported at a price under \$207 per ton.

Mr. Price released this information for the benefit of peanut producers, this support price purchase program

being administered by Commodity Credit Corporation through Farmer's Peanut Cooperatives.

Peanuts sold under this program are delivered to established receiving points, which in Chowan County are the Albemarle Peanut Company, Edenton Peanut Company and Leary Bros. Storage Company. Information regarding the program can be obtained from the County ACA office or any AAA Community Committeeman.

(Continued from Page One) to the fact that the farmers of Chowan County would be able to contribute peanuts, soybeans and corn, primarily, although any other crops and garden produce put up in tin cans will be acceptable.

Farm products contributed throughout the State will be picked up at the farms on December 12 and hauled to a shipping center. Freight cars will be spotted in Edenton and when the loading is completed will be moved to Hertford, Elizabeth City, Camden, Shawboro, and then to the docks in Norfolk for shipment overseas. Non-farm groups will be given an opportunity to contribute financially to the shipping costs of the program in the county.

A feature of the Chowan County meeting was the report of a nominations committee named by Mr. Overman. The chairman, the Rev. E. R.
