Some Progress In **Picking Of Peanuts**

Considerable Portion of Crop, However, Still In Fields

Peanut picking at Northeastern North Carolina points showed a little more progress last week as weather conditions improved some. Reports rom the area indicated that a conderable portion of the crop is still on stacks in the field.

Farmers stock peanuts in all sections of the country continued gen-erally at Commodity Credit support evels in accordance with meat content and the percentage of damage shown by individual lots. Movements of shelled Number 2 peanuts to the Commodity Credit Corporation from the Carolina-Virginia area during the previous week totaled approximately 885,000 pounds according to reports by the U. S. Department of Agricul-

Slightly over 19 million pounds noved to the Corporation in the Southeast and about 21/2 million ounds in the Southwest. Total purhases of farmers stock peanuts under the peanut program through No-vember amounted to about 223 million pounds.


