Arrests In Edenton Total 805 In 1949

Detailed Report Is Compiled By Chief of Police George Dail

According to a detailed report made by Chief of Police George I. Dail, 805 arrests were made in Edenton for the year January 1, 1949 to December 31.

Drunks were far in the lead with 216, followed by 149 miscellaneous traffic violations, 103 miscellaneous arrests and 101 speeders.

Reasons for other arrests were: Disorderly conduct, 56; assault, 91; driving intoxicated, 14; careless and reckless driving, 18; larceny, 31; whiskey violations, 9; indecent exposure, 6; carrying concealed weapons, 6; breaking and entering, 5.

During the year police answered 860 calls, made 218 investigations, recovered \$7,555.67 in stolen property and found 87 doors open.

U. S. Treasurer Will Speak In High Point


