the Edenton Baptist Church, is chairman of the Missions Committee of the association.

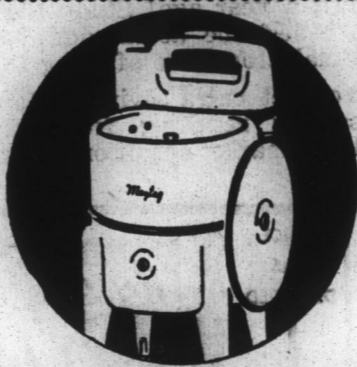
Episcopal Bishop Will Be On Air March 12th
