

## 125,000 Rural Youth In Southern States To Be 4-H Gardeners

### Youngsters Will Compete In National Garden Program

Now that they have received the signal—brightly colored seed catalogues—boys and girls in the Southern states are anxious to get started in becoming expert 4-H gardeners.

It is estimated that more than 125,000 of these rural youth in North Carolina and thirteen other Southern states will take part in the 1950 National 4-H Garden program. In it they will learn how to manage a well-planned garden, carry out a program of vegetable insect and disease control, and market produce in an economical and approved manner.

Through their garden project, they will increase individual and family incomes by reducing the amount of food purchased. They will also contribute to better family health by producing sufficient amounts of essential and nutritious vegetables and fruits for use throughout the year.

## 500 Are Invited To Flood Control Meet

### Hearing Will Be Held In Winton March 6th at 10 A. M.

Almost 500 interested parties have been invited to testify at the March 6 hearing on the Chowan River Flood Control project, which will be held at the Hertford County Court House in Winton beginning at 10 A. M.

Congressman Herbert C. Bonner says that the list of those invited includes representatives of Federal, State, county and municipal agencies; representatives of commercial, industrial, civic, highway, railroad and flood control interests and property owners concerned.

"They will be afforded full oppor-

tunity to express their views concerning the character and extent of the improvements desired," Mr. Bonner assured.

Proponents of the project are urged by the Corps of Engineers to present pertinent factual material bearing upon the general plan of improvement desired and the economic justification of the undertaking.

Opposing interests, if any, will also be heard.

Statements should be written in order to assure accuracy in including them in the records, Mr. Bonner urges that the statements be brief and concise but that they cover the subject.

## Independence Drive Will Start May 15

### Liberty Bell Symbol of 1950 U. S. Savings Bond Campaign

The 1950 U. S. Savings Bonds campaign, to be known as the Independence Drive, will get under way May 15 and run through July 4, Secretary Snyder has announced. The Liberty Bell is the campaign symbol, and "Save for Your Independence," emphasizing the traditional American faith in thrift, is the campaign slogan.

"It is singularly appropriate that this campaign should be known as the Independence Drive, because the spirit of personal independence has motivated our financial as well as our political thinking since our nation's earliest days," Secretary Snyder said.

"As for the Liberty Bell, it symbolizes not only our political independence but also all those characteristics of Americanism which serve to sustain our independence. Of these characteristics, thrift, of course, is one of the most outstanding. Thus in the Independence Drive, the Liberty Bell will be an especially suitable reminder of the importance of savings and

Savings Bonds to our economic life and to the financial independence of the individual."

Ever since the inception of the Savings Bond Program, Secretary Snyder added, it has been recognized as a strong force for the preservation and development of our free enterprise system.

The staff of the Treasury's Savings Bonds Division will meet with volunteer committees representing banking, industry, labor, agriculture, motion pictures, advertising, newspapers, radio, and numerous national organizations to organize the Independence Drive. The Treasury again will depend upon the help of several million volunteers to assure the success of the drive.

### Vets' Question Box

Q. I want to reinstate my National Service Life Insurance converted policy that I allowed to lapse about eight months ago. Will I have to pay for the medical examination with the reinstatement application?

A. If you desire to reinstate your NSLI, you may upon application receive a physical examination free of charge at any VA field office having medical facilities.

Q. Is there a provision that allows monthly income payments to disabled National Service Life Insurance policyholders?

A. A provision may be added to NSLI policies on application of the insured which provides payments of \$5 per month for each \$1,000 of insurance in force. The insured pays a small additional premium to have this protection.

## SPORTS AFIELD

There are hunters who love their dogs and constantly associate with them—men who work their dogs both in season and out. They go in for "class dogs". They understand them. But the average man, the casual hunter, has no business with that kind of dog.

So before starting your search for the right individual of any breed, have frankly and clearly in mind the kind of dog you'll fit. According to Horace Lytle, author of many dog articles and frequent field-trial judge, that's just as important as fitting the dog to the man.

Your interest in dogs and hunting is an index to the kind of dog that will provide the best fit. If you hunt only a few days a year and are not prepared to devote a great deal of time and money in keeping your dog in top condition, a field-trial type pointer or setter will be inappropriate.

A highly keyed dog would fret you to death. You would get a better fit from a cautious, close-working dog. You might find the right one among Brittanys or German shorthairs. If you don't want a dog that points game, investigate the possibility of getting a springer, American water spaniel, Labrador, or others.

A gentleman recently told me that while he has had beagles all his life he now hunts mostly for pheasant in northern Ohio. He loses too many cripples, and wondered about getting either a Chesapeake or Labrador as a game saver. He had something there. An American water spaniel or springer might also suit him admirably. Many beagles are used to hunt pheasant, and the basset is good at this too.

There is a much more certain pattern to follow in choosing hounds. Regardless of difference of opinion as to the respective merit of Walkers,

Julys, Triggs, and others, there is little or no debate as to the proper pattern of performance. Much the same thing is true in the case of retrievers. Pattern of performance is standard, whether one favors the Chesapeake, Labrador, golden or others. It is a different matter when we talk of the dog for upland game birds. You must consider the temperament of the dog—and the master.
