

Boundaries Are Set For Hatteras Park

Area Will Be the First Federal Seashore Park

Boundaries of the proposed Cape Hatteras National Seashore Recreational Area on North Carolina's Outer Banks have been agreed upon. The area, which would be the first federal seashore park, covers rugged country which offers excellent fishing and water fowl hunting.

The boundaries extend on the north from Whalebone, three miles south of Nags Head, to the southern tip of Ocracoke Island. Areas around the Banks villages are exempted to permit expansion to provide facilities for tourists and sportsmen. The boundaries were recommended by the National Park Service and accepted by the North Carolina Cape Hatteras Seashore Commission.

The Park Service specified that the area must include a minimum of 33,000 acres. Already the North Carolina and Federal governments own 12,000 to 15,000 acres within the boundaries. Surveys will determine what land must be acquired and what the actual acreage of the recreational area will be. The committee plans to report to the full commission by December 1 on the estimated cost of acquisition. The next step would be for the commission to ask Governor Scott and the North Carolina Council of State for supplementary funds to cover the estimate. These funds would be turned over to the National Park Service, which would proceed with the acquisition.

Extreme Care Needed In Harvesting Cotton

To bring top prices, cotton should not only be picked clean and picked only when dry, but it should also be kept dry and carried to the gin dry, says David H. Stancil, cotton marketing specialist for the State College Extension Service.

Stancil believes Tar Heel farmers should be very careful in harvesting and selling their cotton this year, especially since the 1950 State crop is one of the shortest in history.

Many farmers have the idea that gins equipped with driers can handle cotton in any condition. This is not true at all, says Stancil. The driers do wonderful work within certain limits, but if cotton is really wet it often has to be put through the drier twice and even then does not come out completely dry.

This slows up ginning and costs money. It also tempts the ginner to run his heat up, which often causes damage to the fiber of the cotton. Farmers will make money every time by keeping their cotton dry.

Already a farmer in the southern part of North Carolina has picked some cotton so trashy that its value, even after going through a modern

gin, was reduced \$10 per bale. The fine new gins which have been erected in North Carolina almost perform miracles in cleaning. However, says Stancil, even with all this equipment, gimmers cannot possibly turn out a sample as clean from dirty, trashy cotton as from cotton brought to them clean.

At present high prices, a farmer may easily lose \$25 a bale by having his cotton picked trashy. Closer supervision of pickers, with premiums for clean picking, would pay in nearly every case.

Road Assured For Pea Island Refuge

The North Carolina State Highway and Public Works Commission has been assured by Congressman Herbert C. Bonner that there will be no delay in securing a right-of-way to construct a highway through the Pea Island Refuge in Dare County.

Mr. Bonner conferred with heads of the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service Friday morning. He later notified N. C. Highway Commission Chairman H. W. Jordan that the right-of-way would be secured to meet any schedule the State required.

The game refuge is in the proposed path of a highway being constructed on North Carolina's Outer Banks.

THE TYPES OF TUBERCULOSIS

the bones and joints, which has left many people crippled, has been almost completely eradicated in this country. Most cases of that form of the disease came from drinking raw milk of tuberculosis cows. Many of the victims who contracted the disease were children under five years of age.

As a result of a campaign begun in 1917, bovine (cattle) tuberculosis has been brought under almost complete control in the United States. Cattle are tested for tuberculosis and slaughtered if they show signs of the disease. As a result, bone and joint tuberculosis is today almost unknown in the United States, although it is prevalent in some other countries. Pasteurization of milk, which kills all germs, has been another factor in cutting down the spread of tuberculosis from cattle to man.

The two most acute forms of tuberculosis, which until recent years were always fatal, are tuberculosis meningitis and miliary tuberculosis. Tuberculosis meningitis, which strikes children most frequently, affects the meninges, or membranes around the brain and spinal cord. In miliary tuberculosis, the tubercle bacilli are spread by the blood stream to various parts of the body where they cause tiny lesions about the size of a millet seed, thus "miliary" TB.

Since the discovery of streptomycin and its use in tuberculosis treatment,

many lives have been saved from these two acute forms of the disease. However, even with streptomycin, not all cases of tuberculosis meningitis or miliary tuberculosis can be saved.

Tuberculosis can and often does strike such organs of the body as the eyes, the glands, and the genitourinary tract. Some of these types of tuberculosis are frequently complications of the pulmonary form of the disease.

A person can protect himself from all forms of this communicable disease by taking care of his health generally, keeping up his body's resistance against a damaging attack of TB germs, and making certain that the milk he drinks is pasteurized. He should also have physical check-ups with his doctor, including chest X-rays (an aid in diagnosing pulmonary tuberculosis), at least once a year to play doubly safe.




