

180 People Share In Old Age Assistance

\$4,504.50 Distributed In Chowan County During September

During the month of September 180 persons in Chowan County received old age assistance in the amount of \$4,504.50. Twenty-five cases of aid to dependent children received \$1,026 and 15 blind aid cases received \$447.

The sum of \$205 was expended for nine general assistance cases and other financial assistance included five persons hospitalized in the county and four hospitalized outside the county.

During the month one adult parolee was under supervision, four persons received veterans rehabilitation in cooperation with the Welfare Department, six child labor certificates were issued, one person was certified for eye examination by the State Commission for the Blind and 25 children received individual service.
