168 Receive Old Age Help During October

During the month of October 168 persons in Chowan received \$4,205 in way of old age assistance. At the same time 24 cases of aid to dependent children received \$990 and 15 aid to blind cases received \$447.

General assistance during the month included four persons hospitalized in the County at a cost of \$75 and three

hospitalized outside the County at a cost of \$50.40.

Service cases included one adult parolee under supervision; three received veterans rehabilitation in cooperation with the Department of Public Welfare; one child labor certificate was issued; two investigations and reports were made for the Chowan County Draft Board; one doe deer was received from the game warden for distribution to two families; one investigation was made for the State

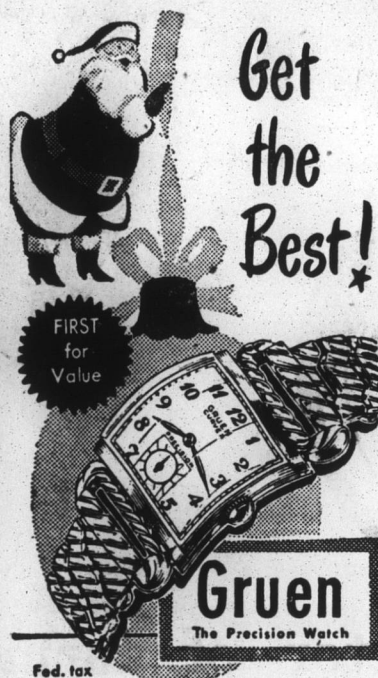

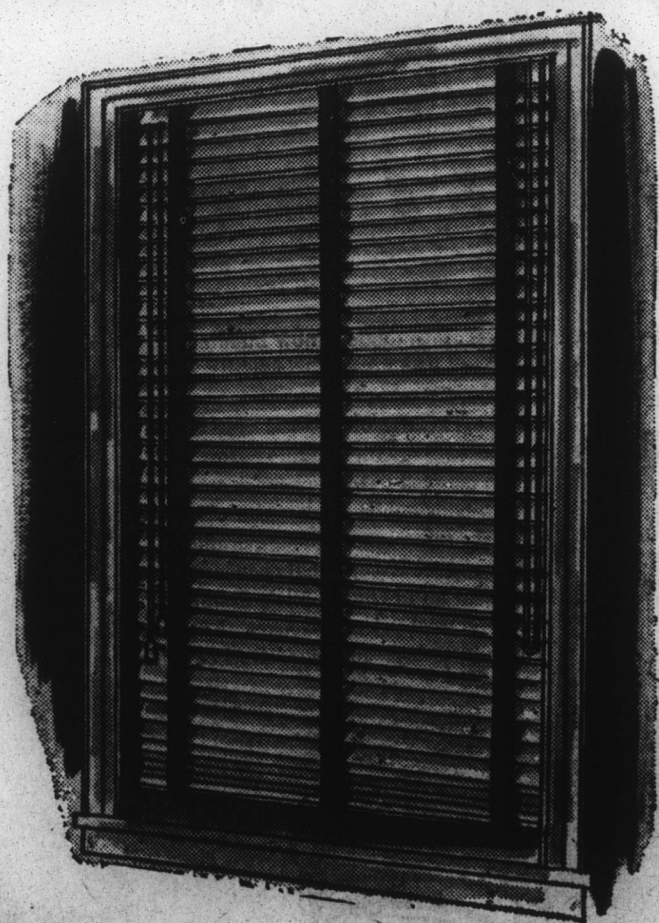
