

## Market Hogs Bring Average Of \$18.57

### Growers Sold 1,319 Hogs For Net Return of \$52,775.74

An average price of \$18.57 per hundred was paid for hogs sold at North Carolina's 11 market hog shows and sales during 1950, according to Jack Kelley, in charge of animal husbandry extension at State College.

Growers sold 1319 hogs weighing 284,269 pounds and received a return of \$52,775.74. The State's largest show was held at Rocky Mount, where 269 head of hogs were sold or exhibited. Highest average price was recorded at Wendell, when 114 hogs sold at an average of 22.65 per hundred.

4-H Club members walked away with a lion's share of the prizes for the year. Nine of 11 grand champions belonged to 4-H Club members and the new State record of \$1.26 per pound was set by a 4-H Club member at Smithfield.

The Grand Jury report was accepted and read to the Board of County

Commissioners.

It was moved and carried that the County Commissioners raise the insurance on the Court House from \$45,000 to \$75,000. The jail at \$5,000 and the County Home property from \$3,750 to \$6,750.

By motion of A. S. Hollowell, seconded by J. R. Peele that the County Commissioners recommend that the State Highway and Public Works Commission widen, ditch and hard-surface the Paradise Road, about 6 1/2 miles.

It was moved and carried that the County donate \$10.00 to the Caswell Training School at Kingston, N. C.

By motion of J. R. Peele, seconded by E. N. Elliott, that Mrs. Annie W. McMullan be appointed tax supervisor to succeed Richard Dixon, to be effective the date of R. D. Dixon's confirmation as postmaster.

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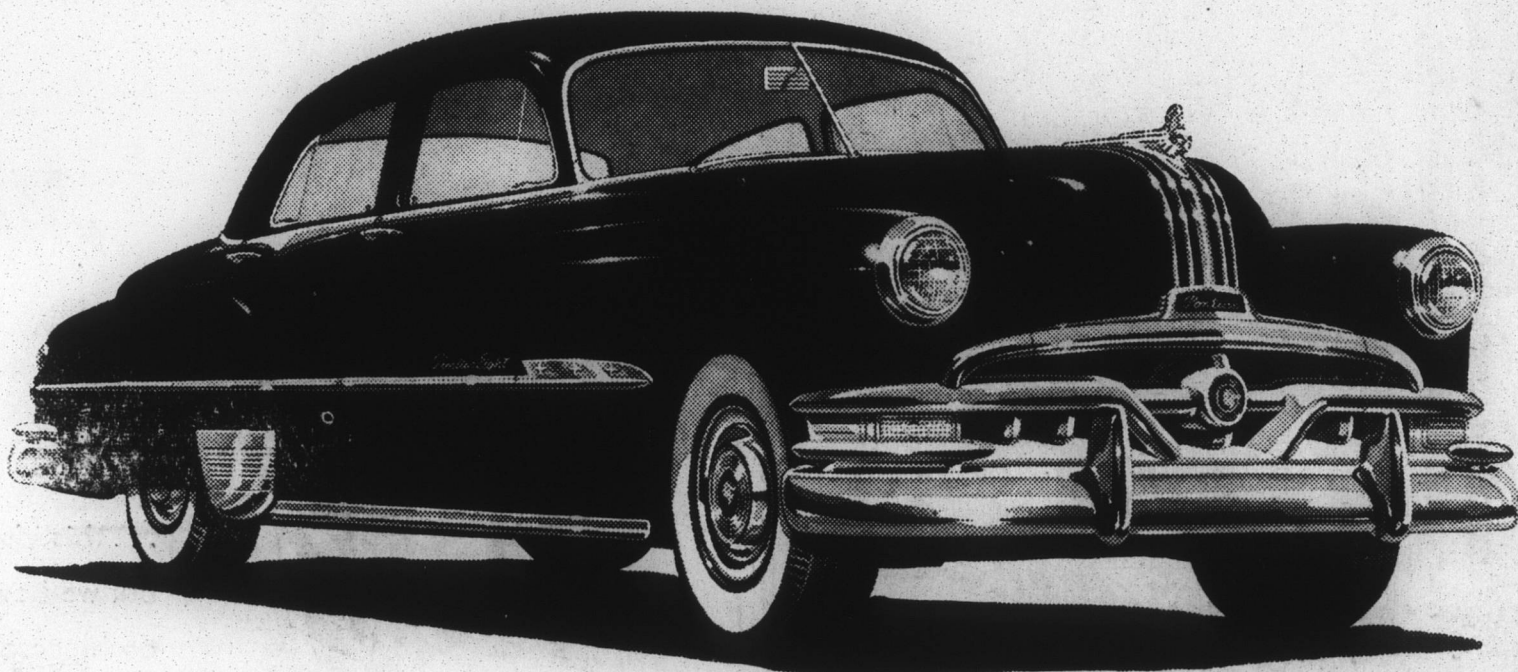


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
