Tractor Maintenance Schools Are Planned

Four-H Club members, agents and leaders from nearly half of the State's 100 counties will attend two three-day tractor maintenance schools to be held at State College during January, according to L. R. Harrill, State 4-H Club leader, and J. C. Ferguson, extension agricultural engineering specialist.

Purpose of the schools is to train leaders to help conduct county schools of a similar nature and to help carry out tractor maintenance projects. Representatives are being selected on the basis of experience with tractors and on their prospect as leaders in this type of work.

Classwork will consist of both lectures and practical work with various

makes and models of tractors. The instruction will be handled by members of the college's Department of Agricultural Engineering. Several films relating to farm machinery will be shown.

The first school, to be held January 22-24, will be for one agent, one 4-H member over 14, and one adult leader from each of the following counties: Brunswick, Columbus, Scotland, Hoke, Montgomery, Lee, Pender, Sampson, Richmond, Onslow, Jones, Robeson, Cumberland, Person, Granville, Caswell, Orange, Guilford, Alamance, Northampton and Wilson.

The second school will be held January 25-27. It will be attended by one agent, one 4-H member over 14, and one adult leader from each of the counties of Stokes, Rockingham, Yadkin, Forsyth, Davie, Davidson, Cabar-

rus, Rowan, Mecklenburg, Stanly, Union, Anson, Pamlico, Craven, Camden, Pasquotank, Gates, Warren, Washington and Tyrrell.
