Host Self-Employed **Required** To Enroll For Social Security

Recent Amendment Includes About Five **Million Persons**

Recent amendments to the Social Security Law extend coverage to about five million self-employed persons. What does this mean to you? It means if you are one of this number, you will have to pay an additional tax on your earned net income for the year 1951 and thereafter. It also means that you will be entitled to all benefits provided by the Old-Age and Survivors' Insurance provision of the Social Security Act.






